

## Meet Our Resident of the Month

### This is my story....David Arlen Johnson

I was born on June 5, 1930 in Lake Stevens, Washington. I am of Norwegian/Swedish decent. My mother's name was Clara Olivia Olsen and she was born in Machias, Washington. She was an excellent homemaker and kept busy caring for her garden and fruit trees. My father, Clarence Manuel Johnson, was born in Litchfield, Minnesota. He and his family moved to Washington when he was four. His career was spent at a shingle mill where he prepared and packed shingles that were to be used on the roof of a home.

I grew up with two brothers...Leland and Victor. We always had dogs and cats but they were never allowed in the house. During one period of time we also raised cocker spaniels. I especially remember my uncle's dog Fritz that we kept for a couple of years. Growing up I enjoyed carving things out of wood and playing football, basketball and baseball during my high school years. My favorite subject in school was "girls." I graduated from Lake Stevens High School in 1949.

After high school I drove a truck for about 18 months before I was drafted into the Army. I was sent to Fort Meade, Maryland to become a medic but with my driving experience my service was changed to driving in the motor pool. I got to do a lot driving while serving in northern Italy during the Korean War. After being discharged from the Army following two years of service, I returned to Washington and got a job at the Mount Vernon Daily Herald in their five year apprenticeship program to become a newspaper pressman. I got my journeyman's card in 1958. I then spent the next 35 years working for the Seattle Times. A favorite memory of my working years was the day President Kennedy was shot and we had to "hold the presses." During those years I was also involved in the community as a Boy Scout's leader and a little league baseball coach.

My children are Laurie, Sam and Misti. I have now been blessed with five grandchildren. When the kids were young, we lived on a circular driveway. The kids used to love riding a small scooter around and around that driveway. I like to think that it helped prepare them to drive! Later my son and I helped to rebuild and get running a Vespa Motor Scooter!

I have been blessed in my lifetime to visit 9 different countries and 25 states including two trips to Alaska. I am especially grateful that I was able to spend 26 winters in Arizona after I retired. I am really proud of the things I have been able to carve out of wood...especially walking sticks. I have also been blessed to be able to play the harmonica and the clarinet which has brought me and at times others great joy!

When I was growing up, my family and I belonged to a non-denominational church that met in a home near our home in Lake Stevens. My favorite hymns are "Beyond the Sunset", "Just a Closer Walk", and "Amazing Grace". As I look back over my life, I have to give a lot of credit to the Dale Carnegie Course that really helped me grow and mature. I went through the course once as a student and three times as a graduate assistant.

One lesson that I would like to pass on to others is that there is no better investment than real estate. Throughout the years I have owned 18 different properties. I would like to be known as a person who didn't take things too seriously.
