Q: Why did the cow cross the road?

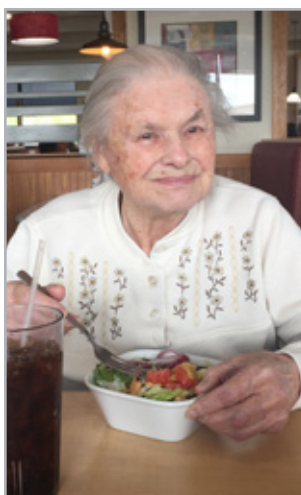
