- Eating an apple can brighten your smile.
- Apples are a source of antioxidants, which can fight cancer. Researchers believe that eating apples on a regular basis may limit the development of Alzheimer's disease and Parkinson's disease.
- One apple has only 50 calories, 2 grams of fiber and no fat.
- The apple blossom is the state flower of Michigan and Arkansas.
- Apples can be kept for up to two weeks in a refrigerator (outside of any packaging).
- The state of Michigan grows more than 20 different kinds of apples. Last year, Michigan farmers sold more than 20 million bushels of apples. Here are a few: Paula Red, McIntosh, Jonathan, Empire, Idared, Rome and Honeycrisp.
