



Each year Hawaii Self Storage (HSS) awards financial scholarships to eligible students to pursue and obtain a college degree. This program is designed to help and support students financially to develop into future leaders in our community. The scholarship will be awarded based on required written essay and eligibility. A total of 10 students will be selected. Completed application and essay must be submitted to your school's college counselor by **FEBRUARY 16<sup>th</sup>**. Selected recipients are announced in **APRIL**.

### **Eligibility**

**Be a Hawaii resident and graduate from one of the following schools:**

Kapolei      Waipahu      Aiea      Pearl City      Mililani      Campbell  
Radford      Moanalua      Farrington      Kaimuki      Kalani      Leilehua      McKinley

**Be enrolled full-time at a college or university.**

The applicant must be enrolled full time and submit a letter of acceptance into a recognized academic degree program. Applicants must be enrolled with a minimum of 12 credits; HSS does not provide funding for part-time enrollment.

**Complete the required attached application and essay.**

(Answer the following 4 questions in less than 2 pages)

- Why do you deserve the scholarship?
- What goals have you set for yourself and your future?
- How will you use your degree to benefit and serve your community?
- What is the biggest problem in Hawaii and how would you solve it?

### **Terms of Scholarship**

4-year maximum term. \$1,000 awarded each year upon renewal qualification.

Student must maintain a minimum cumulative grade point average of **3.0**  
If student fails to qualify, student is still eligible the next year if GPA qualifies.

Submit official school transcripts to Hawaii Self Storage (address below) to renew  
Due date for renewal is **JULY 15<sup>th</sup>**.

All checks will be written to the institution and mailed to recipient.  
Checks will be mailed first week in **AUGUST**.
