

Preventing Skin Breakdown

Do you sit in a wheelchair most of the day while you are up? You can actually exercise while in your chair. When you sit in your chair for long periods of time, your skin can break down causing open sores to develop. This is not a good sign.

- Put your feet flat on the floor and sit up straight. Put your brakes on. Lean forward and touch your toes.
- Sitting in an upright position, lean over to the left and then to the right making sure you get your bum elevated to get air under you relieving the pressure on your buttocks.

These exercises will help blood circulation in your lower extremities which in turn will help your skin from breakdown.
