I have been working in Healthcare for about 7 years now. I've held various positions from private care

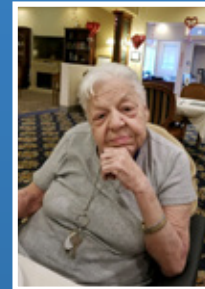
