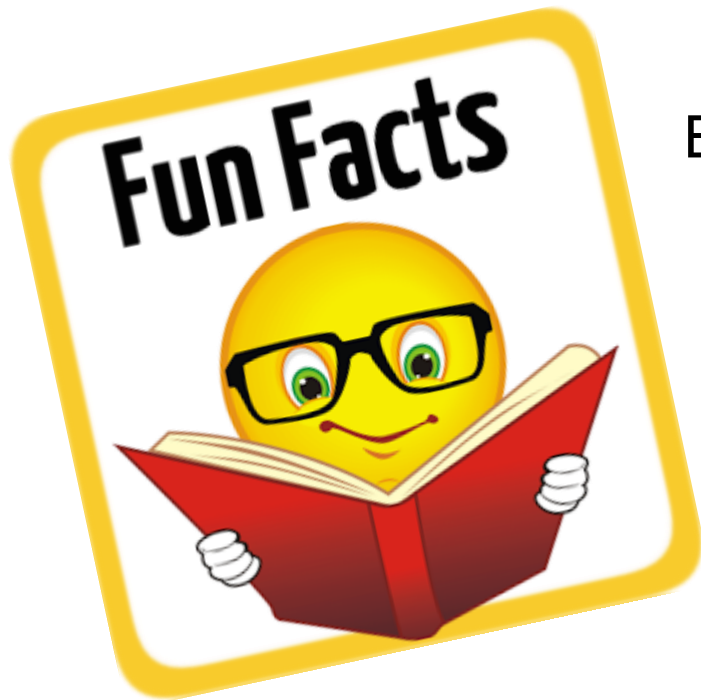


January Employee of the Month
