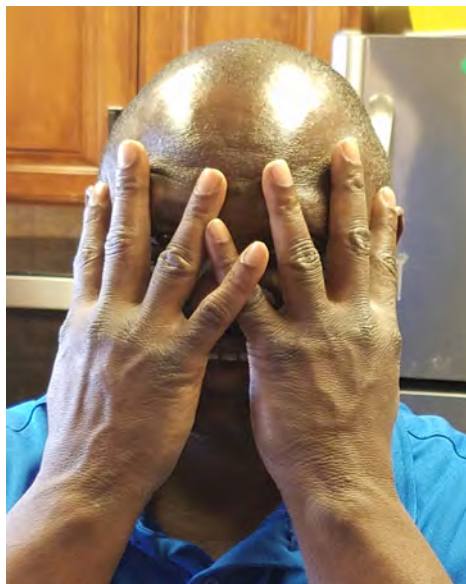
A Note from the Executive Director

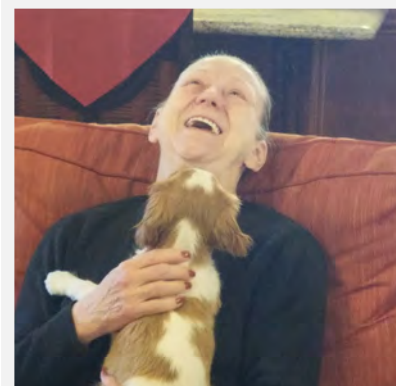

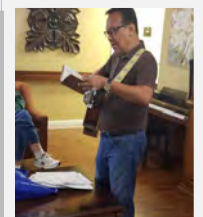
