The Chaplain's Corner "In a World of Despair, Easter Shouts HOPE!"

I am He who lives, and was dead; and, Behold, I AM ALIVE FOREVERMORE..." (Rev. 1:18a)

Years ago, a Navy submarine sunk off the coast of Massachusetts. As it plunged deep into the ocean depths, the Coast Guard dispatched a rescue team. As the crew's oxygen supply diminished with each passing hour, eventually a diver reached the sub on that dark ocean floor. Cupping his ear over the hull to listen for signs of life, he began to hear the familiar dots and dashes of Morse Code being tapped out by one of the crew. Slowly, the message came: "Is...there...any...hope?" Truly, this is the question of mankind! God's answer to this critical question is boldly announced at Easter!

It's because Jesus rose from the dead on Easter morning that all true believers can count on Him for divine help! It's because He conquered death that we can be assured that, "With God all things are possible." (Mark 10:27) "Because He lives, I can face tomorrow" goes that famous Bill Gaither hymn. Because Jesus lives, He can save us, help us, heal us, and bless us. Because He lives, there's hope for the lost, the lonely, the hurting, the discouraged, the weak, the sick, the estranged, the frail, the struggling, and the confused—all who will turn to him in prayer! The Book of Hebrews says it well, "Since we have a great High Priest, who is passed into the heavens, Jesus, the Son of God...let us come boldly unto the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy and find grace to help in time of need." (Heb. 4:14, 16)

Best of all, the believer's hope transcends the grave! As new life springs forth all around us, the season of spring shouts the promise of eternal life for those who embrace the Risen Christ by faith. "I am the Resurrection and the Life," He said, "He who believes in Me, though he be dead, yet shall he live. And whoever lives and believes in Me, shall never die!" (John 11:25-26) Dwight L. Moody, the great evangelist, once testified to the truth of Jesus' promise this way, "Someday, you will read in the papers that Moody is dead. Don't believe a word of it! In that moment, I shall be more alive than I am now!"

As anyone who follows the news can tell, today's world is a world of despair! Happily, in the midst of it all, Easter bursts forth as the basis for real hope! When Billy Graham visited German Chancellor Konrad Adanaur in the early 1950s, the chancellor asked him if he believed in the Resurrection. When Graham said he most certainly did, Adanaur said, he did as well. Then he added, "If Christ is not risen from the dead, there is not one shred of hope for mankind!" Thankfully, we can, indeed, bask in hope today because history testifies to the fact of the Resurrection! The Apostle Peter, who witnessed the Resurrected Lord firsthand along with 500 others, said, "Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who in His abundant mercy has begotten us again into a LIVING HOPE through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead." (I Peter 1:3) To that, we can all shout, "Amen"!
