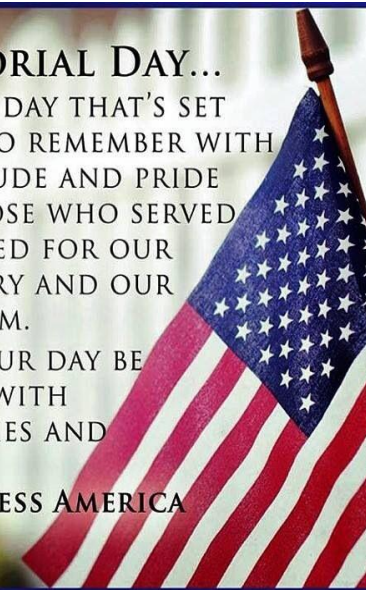

This day was established to honor those who died in the Civil War. It was originally called Decoration Day because they decorated the graves of soldiers lost during the war.

Memorial Day didn't

become a holiday until 1967. Now celebrated on the last Monday in May, this day traditionally marks the start of the summer season.

In December 2000, Congress passed a law requiring Americans to pause at 3pm on Memorial Day to remember and honor the fallen.
