


# A Note from the Executive Director

# Health & Fitness by Colon Cancer

## Awareness

Did you know that colon cancer is the third leading cause of cancer related death in men and women? Knowing the signs and symptoms at an early stage will help you catch and conquer the disease before it is too late.

Symptoms include:

- Cramping belly pain
- Dark or bright red stool
- Stool change from constipation to Diarrhea frequently

#### Whole body symptoms include

- Weight loss
- Loss of appetite
- Unusual tiredness
- Iron deficiency
- Anemia
- Jaundice

Although these signs do not say you have colon cancer, you should get a test done each year after 50. A simple bowel sample that you can do in the privacy of your own home is beneficial. Some doctors may recommend a colonoscopy to make sure you do not have polyps that could be cancerous. It is important to know your body and if you think something is wrong, you should seek medical attention. Colon Cancer is nothing to fool around with. For more information on this topic talk to our nurse or ask vour doctor.
