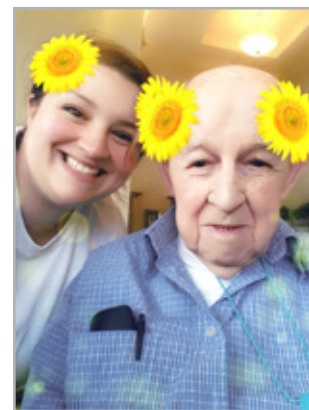

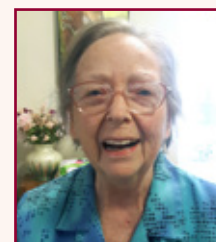

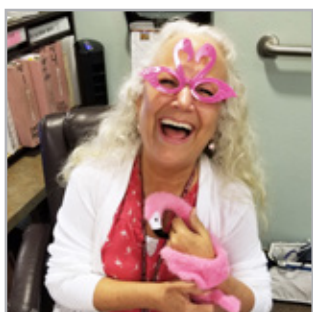
IDA C. —
