








FOCUS ON FITNESS: HOLIDAY HEALTH

Waltonwood offers transportation via bus or car for resident appointments and activity outings Monday through Friday. Please see the front desk receptionist to request a bus trip. We require at least a 24-hour advance notice, but of course, the earlier the better.

The bus is free for trips under 10 miles. If the trip is longer than 10 miles, a fee of \$2 per mile will be charged.

APPLE BERRY PIE

4 medium baking apples, peeled, cored, and sliced 1/4 inch thick

- ¹/₂ cup sugar
- 1 tsp ground cinnamon
- 1/2 tsp ground nutmeg 2 tbsp cornstarch
- 1 cup blackberries
- 1 cup blueberries
- 1 large egg, beaten
- 1 double crust 9-inch pie dough (2 discs)
- 1 large egg, beaten

Preheat oven to 375°F. Set the oven rack in the bottom position. Combine the apples, sugar, cinnamon, nutmeg, and 2 tbsp water in a medium saucepan. Cook over medium heat until the sugar dissolves and the apples release their juices, 4-5 minutes.

In a small bowl, stir the cornstarch into 2 tbsp water until smooth. Whisk the cornstarch mixture into the simmering juices in the saucepan until smooth. Simmer just until the juices thicken, about 1 minute. Stir in the blackberries and blueberries, return to a simmer, and then remove the pan from the heat. Let cool while you roll the dough.

On a floured surface, roll out 1 disc of dough to fit a 9-inch pie plate with about 1 inch of overhang. Roll out the second disc and cut strips or shapes. Pour the filling into the bottom crust. Top with lattice or cut-out design. Brush the crust with egg wash.

Bake on a baking sheet (to catch any drips) until the crust is golden brown and the filling is bubbly, about 45 minutes. (Check halfway through; if top crust is browning too quickly, loosely cover with foil.) Let cool. Enjoy!
