- Oral Evaluation and Professional Dental Cleaning - The procedure is performed while the patient is under general anesthesia and being provided with comprehensive patient monitoring. During the procedure our patients will receive an IV catheter, supportive fluids, and patient warming. A full dental evaluation will be performed including dental radiographs, gingival probing, and dentistry charting. An ultrasonic cleaning will be performed above and below the gum line; the enamel of the teeth will then be polished in order to stop the progression of periodontal disease. *Extractions and oral surgery are at an additional cost.*

- Spay/Neuter - Pre-anesthetic blood work is performed prior to or on the day of the procedure. The procedure is performed while the patient is under general anesthesia and being provided with comprehensive patient monitoring. During the procedure our patients will receive an IV catheter, supportive fluids, and patient warming. After the procedure a pain management injection or oral pain management medication will be administered to ensure our patients' best comfort during recovery.\*\* *Cryptorchid and in-heat surgeries are at an additional cost.*
