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Touring Tips

• FIRST IMPRESSION

Were you greeted promptly by front desk staff and offered assistance?

• **OBSERVE TEAM MEMBERS**

Observe team member and resident interactions. Are the team members patient and kind? Were you greeted by residents?

OBSERVE RESIDENTS

Observe residents socializing and/or attending activities. Ask residents about their experiences.

- **REVIEW PLANNED ACTIVITIES** Is an activity calendar readily available? Are the activities things you enjoy?
- NOTE THE CONDITION OF THE ENVIRONMENT Is the building clean and odor free?
- NOTE SAFETY CONDITIONS Are the hallways, doorways and common areas conducive for safe walking?
- TAKE THE TIME TO HAVE A MEAL Is the service friendly and attentive? Are the dining hours and food choices flexible? Did the dining team meet your food handling expectations?
- **MEET THE GENERAL MANAGER AND KEY STAFF** How many team members are scheduled? Check on evening availability and a system for obtaining assistance 24-hours a day.
- ASK ABOUT TRAINING AND CREDENTIALS Is there a licensed nurse? How many hours per day or per week is the nurse in the building?
- **REVIEW STATE SURVEY** Is the most recent state survey available for review?
- NOTE YOUR FINAL IMPRESSIONS Does the community feel like home?
