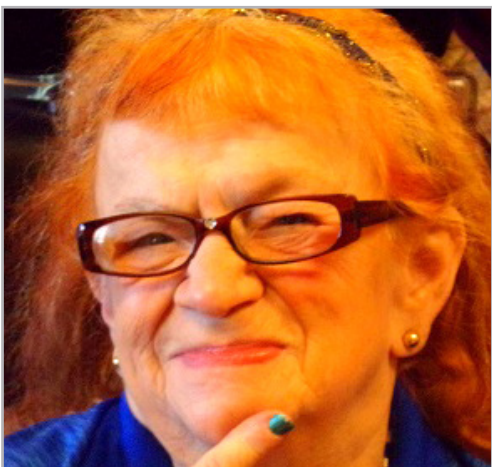
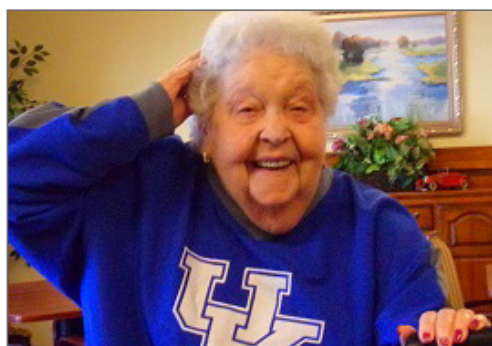
Smile of The Month
