




We are so glad to have you join our family here at Gracious Living. Here's a poem for you, Ron McGaughey and Patricia Stewart.

The Meaning of Easter

What does Easter mean to you? According to the dictionary, Easter, also called Resurrection Sunday, is a festival and holiday celebrating the resurrection of Jesus from the dead, described in the New Testament as having occurred on the third day of his burial after his crucifixion.

Easter is symbolized in many forms. To many children, coloring and hiding eggs, and waking up to pretty goody-filled baskets brought by the Easter Bunny is the way they think of Easter ... as many of us did when we were children. In my family, we all received new outfits and to us girls it meant lacey dresses, white shoes with lace-trimmed socks, white gloves and a pretty new purse. The boys got a new suit and shoes. Church was where we went every Sunday, but Easter was always a special service.
