4. Playing BINGO on Mondays and Wednesdays at 3:00pm.

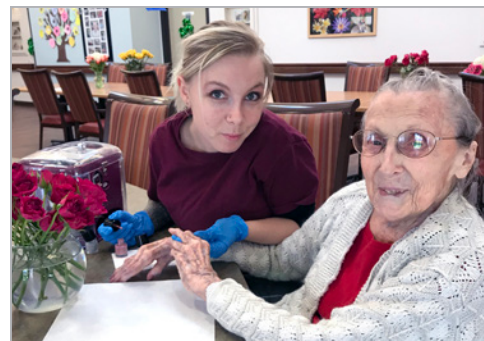

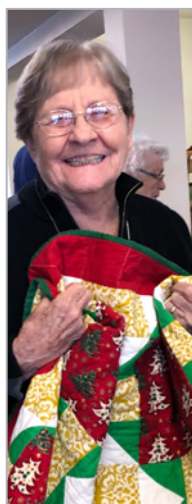
