OUT AND ABOUT

During the month of March we were able to get out and enjoy the warm weather to visit our local maple syrup farm. Harris Sugar Bush Maple Syrup Farm is located just north of Greencastle. As our group trudged through the mud we were able to learn about the collection, purification, and evaporation processes the farm uses to collect and make their syrup. The farm has multiple acres of sugar maple trees they use to collect sap from to eventually turn into syrup. They have over 15 miles of tubing that help to transfer the tree sap to different collection tanks. The residents were able to get a behind the scenes experience as they viewed the tubing, collection tanks, and the evaporator. Harris Sugar Bush makes many different grades of syrup to sell in their gift shop along with the many other treats they have to offer.
