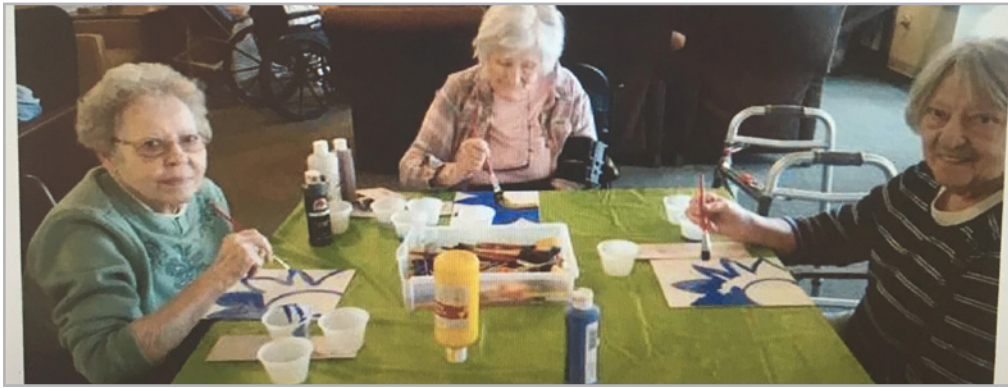

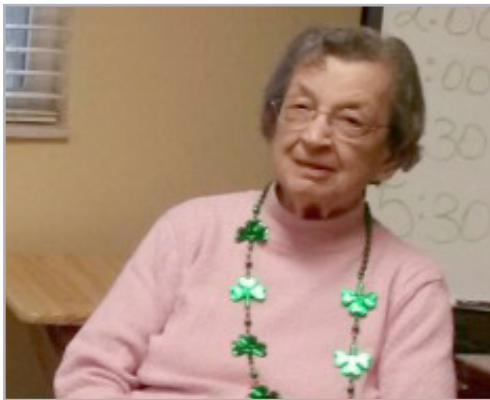
The ladies in Legacy Lane made some lovely paintings with beautiful colors. We all had fun making them!
