



Are you planning a Summer Vacation?

While boarding facilities have specific vaccine requirements, it is not always clear when your pet should receive the vaccines relative to when they will be boarded.

The American Animal Hospital Association (AAHA) recommends the following:

When vaccination is recommended, dogs intended to be housed in boarding kennels or day-care facilities should BEGIN the initial vaccination series 4 weeks prior to entry (2 weeks between the initial vaccines plus 2 weeks to allow time for a humoral immune response to develop).

Plainly stated, your pet should be examined and receive their vaccines a minimum of 2 weeks prior to boarding.

This time period allows your pet's immune system to prime itself for exposure to a new environment and new furry friends.
