How We Use iN2L

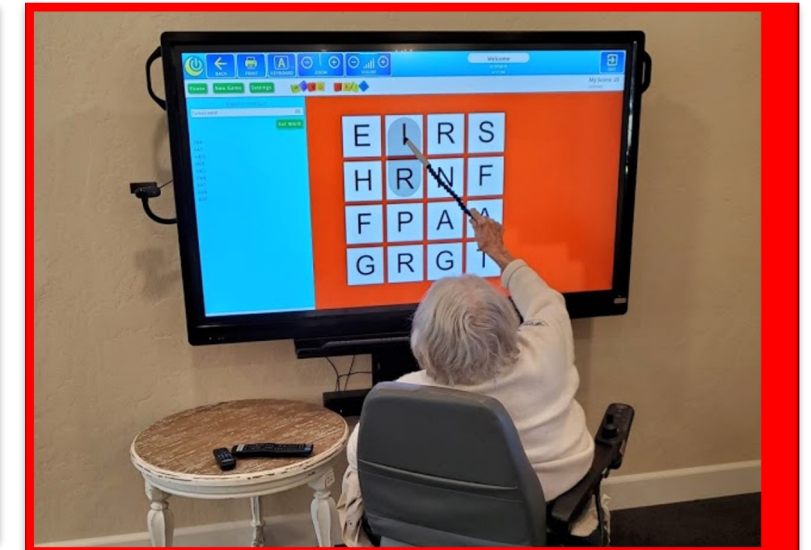

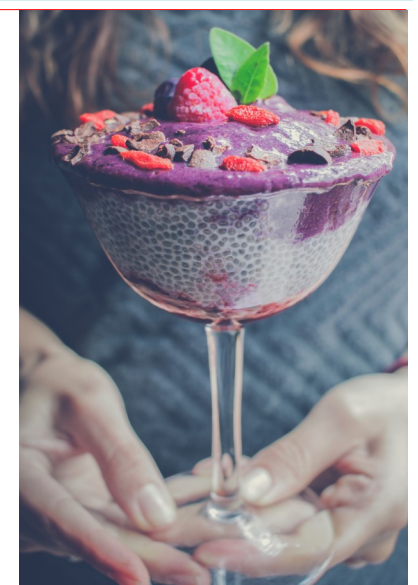
