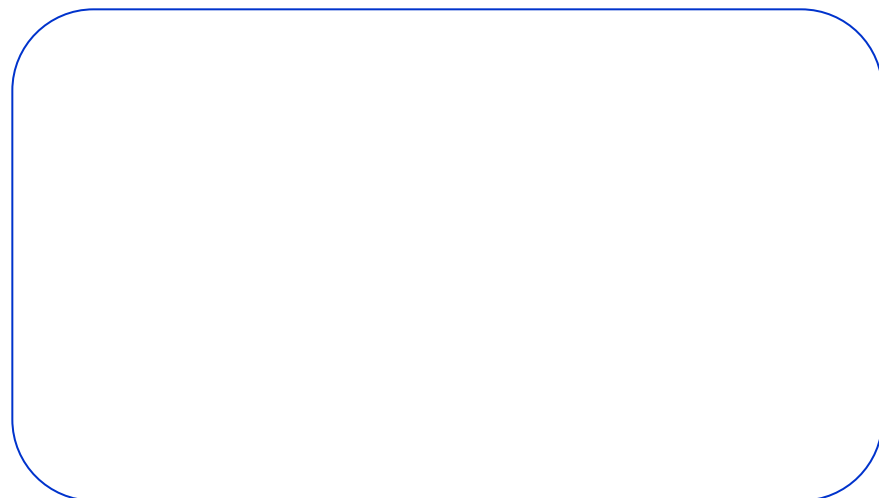

Unusual Facts About The 4th of July

Most of us know about the signing of the Declaration of Independence and the Revolutionary War, but July 4th itself has a pretty interesting 240 year history.

Here are some fascinating facts you probably didn't know about the famous holiday.

1. Only 2 people actually signed the Declaration of Independence on July 4th: John Hancock and Charles Thomson, most of the others signed on August 2nd.
2. Three US presidents have died on July 4th—John Adams, Thomas Jefferson, and James Monroe.
3. On July 4, 1778 George Washington ordered a double ration of rum for his soldiers to celebrate the holiday.
4. July 4th wasn't deemed a federal holiday until 1870, nearly 100 years after the nation was founded.
5. Fireworks have been a major part of Fourth of July since the earliest celebrations. In 1884, miners blew up the post office in Swan, Colorado, because it wasn't supplied with fireworks.
6. Americans consume around 155 million hotdogs on the 4th of July each year. They also spend \$92 million on chips, \$167.5 million on watermelon and \$341.4 million on beer.
7. Not everyone was on board with celebrating on July 4th, the day Congress approved the Declaration. John Adams wanted to celebrate on July 2nd, the day Congress voted for independence.
