

Notes from our Administrator

Now that it is officially Summer, make sure you are staying cool and hydrated. Did you know that the Human Body is made up of 50-60% water in adults? As the temperatures rise, we tend to sweat losing water. If we don't consume water, we are at risk for dehydration and heat stroke in the hotter months. Some symptoms of these include headache, confusion, weakness, disorientation, nausea/vomiting, dizziness or lightheadedness.

Often times, these result in hospitalization and if left unattended, could lead to death. I would like to ask you to coordinate with Kori if you need to run errands and request that outside activities be conducted in the morning or the late afternoon. If you are going for a walk off premises, please wear light weight clothing, bring water to drink, sign out, and notify a staff member. Consider drinking an extra glass of water during meals and order food items that offer more water content. Please maintain your thermostats to keep your environment cool and alert us immediately if your air conditioner is not working properly. We have extras on hand so that you can remain safe, even when equipment fails.
