What is Independence From Hunger?

The Independence from Hunger Campaign, which first began in 2008, is one of two annual

companywide fundraisers that we are proud to support. The campaign began to address the fact that more than 5 million senior citizens currently face hunger in our country. Last year, we provided over 1.5 million pounds of food to benefit local food banks and nonprofit organizations. This year, we hope to collect 1.6 million pounds of food through unique, local fundraising events held at all of our Trilogy Senior Living Communities throughout Kentucky, Indiana, Ohio and Michigan.

How Can I Help?

If you or a family member would like to help us achieve this year's goal, we'll be accepting non-perishable food items until July 15th. This will provide us with ample time to distribute your contributions to our local food bank partner. We're also happy to accept any of the following cash donations:

Themed Dinner




