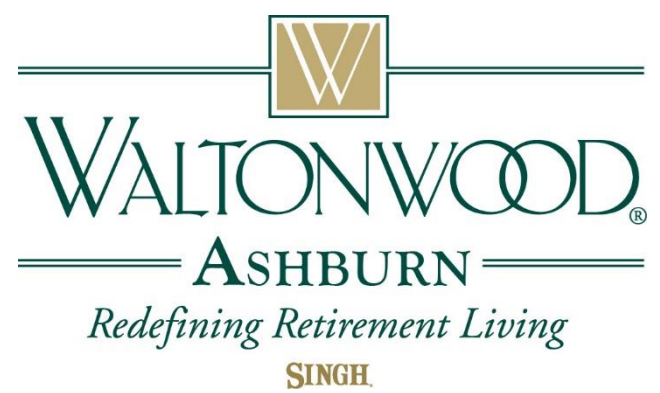

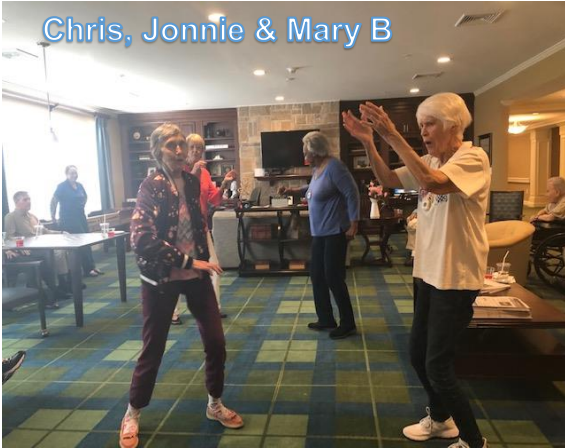
WALTONWOOD SALON
