Romesco Pasta Salad

1lb rotini pasta

1lb vine-ripe tomatoes, diced

4oz shredded parmesan

1 cup basil, chopped

2 garlic cloves, minced

1 lemon, juiced

1 cup roasted red peppers, sliced

1 cup toasted walnuts, chopped

1/2 cup olive oil

Boil rotini pasta, strain and cool. Mix all ingredients in a bowl. Add salt and pepper to taste.
