They told me my mom went to Milford Hospital to pick up a very special present. I was so excited! It just had to be the pony I'd been hoping for. But Santa had other plans; he brought me a baby brother instead, born on Christmas Day. I'll admit, the baby was kind of fun — sort of an interactive toy that made funny noises. And I got a Prairie Rose cowgirl outfit as a consolation prize. But where's the pony? Although hope springs eternal, the only hooves I've heard on the roof since then belong to Santa's reindeer.


