Some words from Mike:


I grew up in Shrewsbury, Massachusetts and I got married in 1979. I lived in Dudley for two years and

### Over The Rainbow Trivia

October 19th is Scarecrow Saturday! In honor of this fun holiday, we'll show "The Wizard of Oz," the film with one of the most beloved scarecrows of all time. Then, after the movie, we'll pass out this fun trivia sheet to test your knowledge of this classic film!

- In the book, Dorothy's slippers are silver. They were changed to ruby red in the film because the color popped much nicer against the technicolor yellow brick road.
- 2. The scarecrow face makeup that Ray Bolger wore consisted, in part, of a rubber prosthetic with a woven pattern to suggest burlap cloth. By the time the film was finished, the prosthetic had left a pattern of lines on his face that took more than a year to vanish!
- 3. Many of the Wicked Witch of the West's scenes were cut because they were thought to be too frightening for children.
- 4. The horses in the Emerald City palace were colored with Jell-O crystals. The scenes had to be filmed quickly because the horses kept licking it off.
- 5. Judy Garland was asked to wear a corset throughout filming to

- make her look more childlike even though she was just 16 when filming.
- 6. The fire that engulfs the Witch's hands as she's trying to remove the ruby slippers is actually apple juice spewing out of the shoes the film was then sped up to make it look more like fire.
- 7. Four sets of slippers were used in the film, one pair of which was stolen from a museum in Minnesota in 2005. They were insured for \$1 million.
- 8. The film won two Oscars. One for best original score and another for best original song.
- 9. The early technicolor process required a lot of
  - lighting, which often made the studio set 100 degrees while shooting.
  - 10. The Cowardly Lion's costume weighed 90 pounds and was made of real lion pelts. The actor would get so warm in his costume, he would have to take it off between takes.
