Albertsons Stadium.

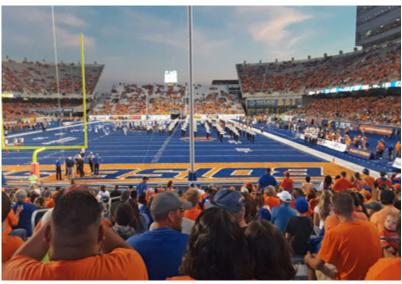
The crowd was mostly orange (Bronco colors) all the way around, families from all over Idaho, big fans!

## Avocado and Kale Superfood Information

#### **Nutritional Value of Avocado:**

Avocados are a great source of vitamins C, E, K, and B-6, as well as riboflavin, niacin, folate, pantothenic acid, magnesium, and potassium. They also provide lutein, beta-carotene, and omega-3 fatty acids.

#### **Nutrition Value of Kale:**

While cooked kale is still very nutritious, cooking kale drastically lowers the amount of antioxidants and zinc contained in the kale, making raw kale a better option. A one-cup serving of chopped, raw kale contains 34 calories, 2.2 grams of protein, 0.5 grams of fat and 6.7 grams of carbohydrates, including 1.3 grams of fiber. This is five percent of the daily value for fiber and four percent of the DV for protein.

Champion all around!

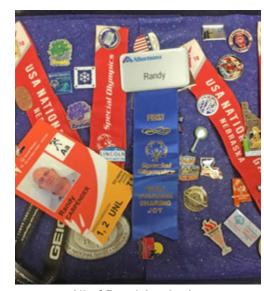
