Residents celebrated the ringing in of the new year with games, food and fellowship. Happy 2020!



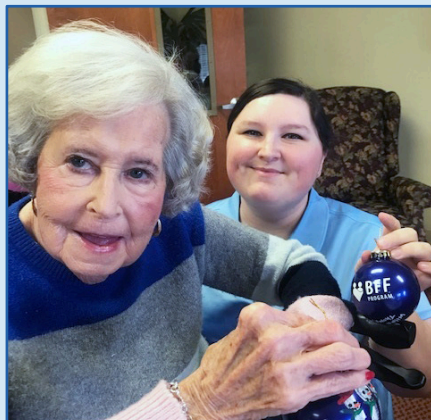
MUSIC TO MY EARS
