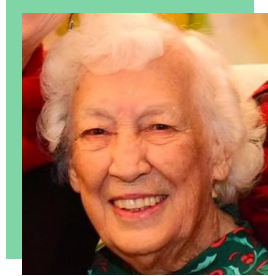

In 1989, Carl got a divorce. He married Althea. Carl said she was a very good person and a great cook. His children liked her. She passed away in 2013 with COPD.

Carl moved to Redding because his whole family lives here. He has been at River Commons for two years. He likes it here, it is home. The food is good, the people are good. 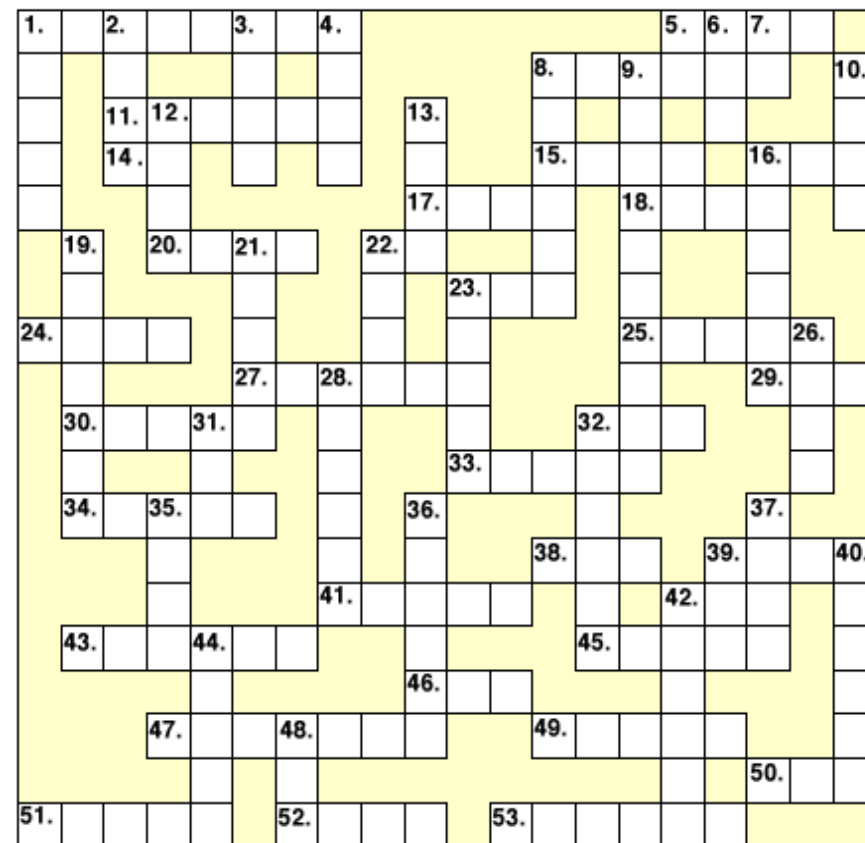
