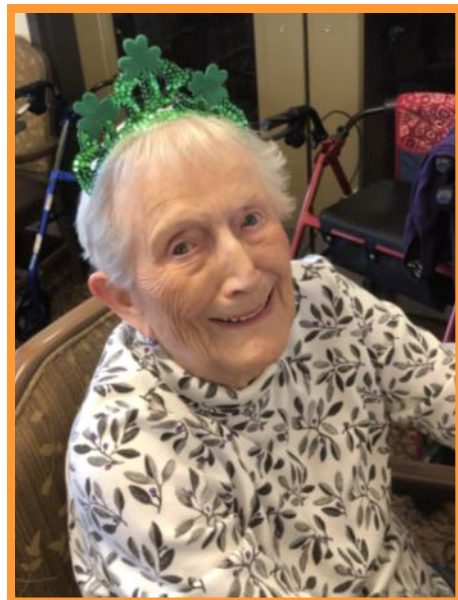
**If you had one Super Power, what would it be?**
