Dear Residents and Family Members,

As you are all aware, we have been working in concert with the Oakland County Health Department since the beginning of the Covid-19 pandemic. They have been an invaluable resource for us as we work to keep our residents and team members healthy and happy. They have been instrumental in developing systems and processes over the past months that have proved to protect seniors in our community as well as others. One item of importance that has dramatically improved is the availability of testing. Oakland County has graciously offered to provide testing for all residents, team members, and private duty caregivers/resident assistant. We have accepted this offer and felt this would be a monumental step in reopening our community and providing data to the local Health Division.

Therefore, the Oakland County Health Department will be onsite on Thursday, June 4th to administer testing. We need to have a full roster completed and submitted to them by 9:00am on Monday so they can complete the testing paperwork prior to arriving at the community. **IF** you have a private caregiver/resident assistant, we will need the following information:

Caregiver/ Resident Assistant Information

Full Name, Date of Birth, Home Address, Phone Number, Email Address, Gender, Race

Your resident assistant/ caregiver(s) will need to be onsite on Thursday for the testing to take place. We strongly encourage **ALL** resident assistant/ caregivers to be tested to keep our community as safe as possible. Please contact them and plan accordingly.

Testing will be conducted from unit to unit, so there is no need to leave your apartment. Testing results will inform the Health Division of the presence of individuals with asymptomatic disease and the potential for spread in our community. These results will be shared between the Health Division, key staff at All Seasons of Rochester Hills, and care providers so we can work together to develop and implement infection control strategies if needed. Results typically are returned to the Health Department in 48-72 hours.

We are grateful for your support and the support of Oakland County as we continue to do everything that we can to keep everyone healthy and happy. These results will not only help us but will better define the best course of future action throughout Oakland County.
