Dear Residents and Family Members,

We have been thrilled to reintroduce some outdoor entertainment and programs over the past few weeks. We are still awaiting recommendations and guidance from the Oakland County Health Division and the State of Michigan on when we can allow visitors and reopen our dining rooms again. We will be sure to communicate with you as soon as we receive this information. In the meantime, these items will continue:

- Residents are able to enjoy walks outdoors or throughout the community at their leisure.
- Full housekeeping will continue in all residences.
- Individual transportation can be booked for any needs. Trips will be limited to one household per trip. This means that you will not be able to go with your neighbor somewhere due to not being able to properly socially distance.
- Health screening before entering the community will continue for all. Per Executive Order 2020-108, we will not be allowing guests until at least June 26<sup>th</sup>.
- Small group indoor activities and outdoor activities will continue to increase.
- As discussed in prior communications, we will continue to enforce appropriate social distancing and mask-wearing practices until further notice.

We are extremely grateful that we do not have any active cases in our communities currently. We thank you for all your cooperation and support to help us all achieve this! We will continue to do everything that we can to provide a happy and healthy environment for our beloved residents and valued team members.
