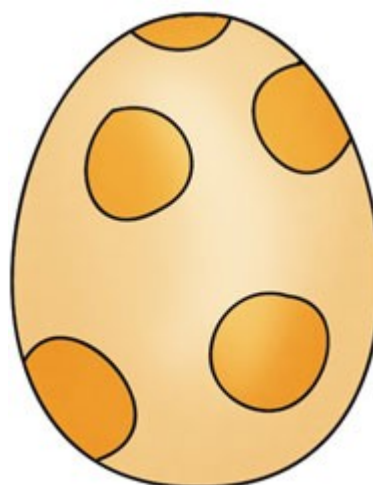

Not only is Shelby always reliable, but she is always willing to pick up shifts for her co-workers. Shelby works fast and efficiently and always produces quality work.

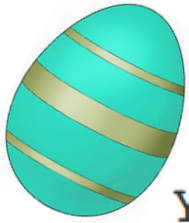

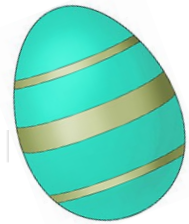

Peanut Butter Marshmallow Cookies

Ingredients

• 1/4 C butter • 1/4 C sugar • 1/4 C brown sugar • 1/4 C peanut butter • 1/4 C marshmallow fluff • 1 egg • 1/2 tsp vanilla • 1 C flour • 1/2 tsp baking soda • 1/4 C peanut butter chips • 1/2 C mini marshmallows



Recipe of the Month

Peanut Butter Marshmallow Cookies

Directions

- 1. Preheat oven to 350. Line a baking sheet with parchment paper.*
- 2. Beat butter and sugars in a large bowl until light and fluffy.*
- 3. Stir in peanut butter, marshmallow fluff, egg, and vanilla. Stir in flour and baking soda. Mix until just combined.*
- 4. Fold in peanut butter chips and mini marshmallows.*
- 5. Drop a tablespoon onto the prepared baking sheet.*
- 6. Bake 10-12 minutes. Allow to cool 5 minutes before transferring to a cooling rack.*

Makes 12 servings.

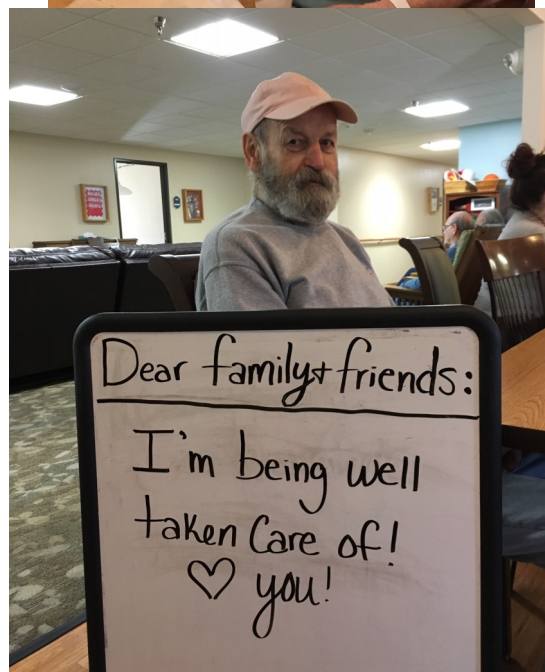
