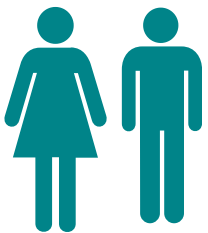

General or Family Visitors or friends and individuals visiting residents in end of life situations.



Essential Visitors are given consent by the resident to provide services and/or assistance with Activities of Daily Living (ADL) and/or emotional support to help maintain or improve the quality of care or quality of life for a community resident.



Compassionate Care Visitors are given consent and designated as providing emotional support to help a resident deal with a difficult transition or loss. Compassionate care visitors may be allowed entry into the community on a limited basis for this specific purpose.

Visitation shall take place ...

- In designated area(s)
- After health screening and temperature check
- With staff monitoring, infection control and prevention, hand hygiene, social-distancing and proper disinfecting before and after each visit.

All Inspired Living Visitors must utilize Inspired Living Provided Personal Protective Equipment kits which include surgical mask, gown & gloves

Essential caregiver or compassionate care visitor at a time.



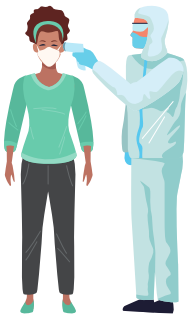
Visitors must log in:

- Name of individual visiting
- Date and time of entry
- Health screening

Limit visits to less than 40 minutes per visit & allow time for proper cleaning and accommodate multiple visits.



Compassionate care visitors and essential care givers will be provided infection control training including, proper use of personal protective equipment (PPE), hand hygiene, and social distancing.



General visitors must:

- Be 18 year of age or older.
- Consent to understanding visitation and infection control policy.
- Maintain social distance of six feet with all residents and staff.
- No outside food or beverages are permitted during visitation.



General visitation must immediately cease if a resident tests positive for COVID-19 (or is exhibiting symptoms indicating he or she is presumptively positive), or if an associate who is in the community 10 days prior tests positive for COVID-19.

All visitors must immediately inform the community if they develop fever or symptoms consistent with COVID-19 or test positive for COVID-19 within 14 days of visit to the community.

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
