



## Culinary Corner with Mary

#### **Chicken Salad with Bacon, Lettuce and Tomato**

Servings **6** Preparation time **15mins** 

#### INGREDIENTS

3 cups chopped cooked chicken breast 5 slices bacon 2 stalks celery, chopped 1 cup chopped fresh tomato 3/4 cup mayonnaise 1 tablespoon chopped fresh parsley 2 tablespoons chopped green onion 1 teaspoon lemon juice 1 dash Worcestershire sauce Salt and pepper to taste 12 leaves romaine lettuce 1 avocado - peeled, seeded and sliced PREPARATION Step 1

Place bacon in a large skillet and cook over medium-high heat, turning occasionally, until evenly browned, about 10 minutes. Drain bacon slices on paper towels; crumble.

#### Step 2

Stir chicken, bacon, tomato, and celery together in a bowl.

#### Step 3

Whisk mayonnaise, parsley, green onions, lemon juice, Worcestershire sauce, salt, and black pepper together in a bowl until dressing is smooth. Pour dressing over chicken mixture; toss to coat. Refrigerate until chilled, at least 30 minutes.

#### Step 4

Stir chicken mixture and serve over romaine lettuce leaves; garnish with avocado slices. Enjoy!


