Merle was born on a farm in northern Iowa. In the Signal Corps, Merle was a cryptographer and was given top secret clearance. His unit was responsible for handling all of the top secret messages coming and going for General MacArthur and his staff at the Headquarters for the South Pacific.

Merle's unit knew something was afoot and that an attack was being planned on Japan before the bombs were dropped. However, no mention of the bombs were ever sent over the radio. That operation was more than top secret. All the troops were excited when the war was over. However, the nature of Merle's position meant he and his fellow cryptographers had to stay 6 months longer than all the others so they could be there during the negotiation of the surrender.

After 6 months, most of the troops were gone. Luckily, a navy cruiser happened to be going by and they caught a ride into San Francisco. When they arrived, they were greeted by a WAC band—Women's Army Corps Band. From there Merle took a train home, went to the University of Iowa and started a company of his own. His company was based in Dallas TX where he lived with his wife and children until about 28 years ago when Merle moved to Crested Butte Colorado. Merle learned to ski at 66 years old and skied into his early 80s. He continues to reside in Colorado and we are lucky to have him as a part of our community.

Unfortunately for us he still won't tell any of General MacArthur's secrets!
