



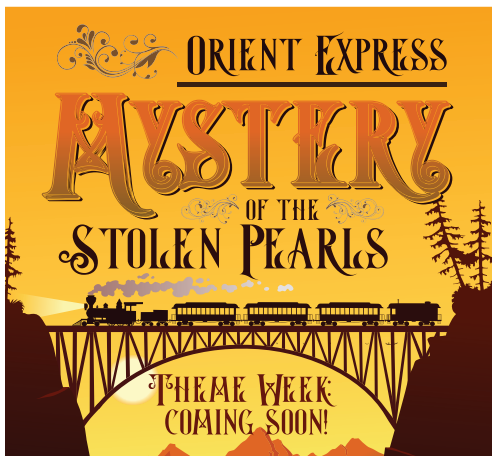

## Ecuadorian Couple Celebrates 79 Years of Marriage

Julio Cesar Mora Tapia (aged 110) and Waldramina Maclovia Quinteros (aged 104) have a cause for celebration! Having tied the knot in 1941, the husband and wife are now happy to be celebrating 79 years of marriage – a new world record for the longest life spent together.

The pair was married at the oldest church in Quito: La Iglesia de El Belén. As he looks back on the day that he said “I do,” in Ecuador’s capital, Julio Cesar recalls what made him fall in love with Waldramina in the first place: her beauty, her heart, and the joy of sharing a conversation with her. For Waldramina, she recognized Julio Cesar as a poet, and was immediately drawn to his young spirit.

Seven years prior to their marriage, fate would have the couple meet when Waldramina decided to visit her sister’s apartment during a school vacation. Julio Cesar lived in the same

apartment complex, so it didn’t take long for he and Waldramina to become friends. Flash forward to 2020, and the pair now has five children, 11 grandchildren, 21 great-grandchildren, and 9 great-great-grandchildren.

When asked what the secret was to a lifelong marriage, the pair cited love, maturity, and mutual respect.

“It is true that at this time it is difficult because we are overwhelmed by the pandemic that affects the world, and we still do not have a solution. However, the first step for us is to follow the rules, and to respect and love the life.”
