# **Voting Information**

Tith the election coming up soon, we have important information about how you can vote.
You have two options:

### **Option one: Absentee Request**

- We can provide you the paperwork to request a ballot—if you need assistance filling it out Life Enrichment can help.
- You **MUST** have your request in **No Later** than **October 25**.
- Ballots will be mailed starting October 5 and 6
- You will receive an orange colored card in the mail—this states that your ballot request has arrived
- We will host a clinic in the second week of October for those who will need help filling it out.

### **Option two: Polling Station**

• You may have a family member take you to your local polling place. You will need to quarantine for 14 days, no exceptions. Family is to only take you to the polling station, no additional stops. This is for your health. Wear your mask the whole trip.

# **New Visiting Policy**

### **Window Visits**

Staring November 1, 2020 we are moving back to window visits. We are starting it early to be prepared for when the weather changes to being cold. During the month of October visits being indoors or outdoors will be determined by staff based on current weather conditions.

You must schedule a visit. Due to the limited area available, we will not be doing walk-in appointments.

Appointments may be scheduled during the timeframes below:

Monday - Friday: 9am - 3:30pm Saturday & Sunday: 10:30am - 1pm

Please note that weekend times will fill up quickly. If you are interested in one of these times please schedule early. Visits will take place at the front entrance of the 202 building.

Appointments are limited to thirty minutes to allow us proper sanitizing time between parties. Please arrive on time to ensure maximum time with your loved one.

We cannot guarantee weekly visits at this time as we need to ensure all families are given the chance to see their loved ones.

When you make your appointment we will need your name and phone number. We are allowing only one visitor at a time.

It is mandatory that all visitors wear a mask and stay six feet apart from the resident. This is for your loved ones safety. We will have visitors sit in the entry way. We will have seating available for your loved one on the other side of the glass. Please bring a cell phone to communicate.

If any of the above policies are violated we reserve the right to end the visit early. We also reserve the right to change or cancel visits as we track COVID trends in our area. **Fast Summary:**


### **Hair Salon**
