As a courtesy notice, yesterday, October 16, we had an employee report to us that a family member living in their household tested positive for the coronavirus. The staff member worked in the memory care program and has not exhibited any signs or symptoms. Because of being in close contact with a family member who has tested presumptive positive, the employee will not be allowed to return to work for ten (10) days and must follow all CDC guidelines and requirements with Florida’s Department of Health.

Also, out of an abundance of caution and everyone’s peace of mind, we completed rapid tests yesterday on all memory care support residents. We also performed contact tracing and tested any staff who may have come in contact with the employee. We are pleased to report that all rapid test results were “negative” for residents and staff members.
