Max had many jobs in his life time, some that he is proud of are: He was a small farm owner, he was co-owner of a cold storage plant, and he worked for Boeing.


If you had one Super Power, what would it be?

Hello wonderful people of Moran Vista!



I want to give you the final update on the flu shot clinic that will be hosted here at Moran Vista and provided by Walgreens.

A Walgreens representative will be here on either November 3rd, 4th, or 5th from 9:00AM-12:00PM to provide flu shot vaccinations to all employees and residents who signed up to receive one. I will soon be receiving confirmation of which date from them and will place flyers around the building with the date and time and where in the building we will be doing it.

Please be sure to bring \$70 in cash along with your most updated insurance cards. The shot will not be administered unless you have the insurance information and ability to pay. The Walgreens representative will then be able to communicate to you exactly how the shot will be paid for, whether fully by your insurance, fully with cash, or a mixture of the two with a co-payment.

Thank you for your patience everyone and remember the most effective way to not get sick is to frequently wash your hands!
