Her desire to learn more about other parts of the country and minority cultures led her to apply for a position with the Bureau of Indian Affairs teaching in the remote four corners area of Teec Nos Pos, Arizona.

Glenda met her husband Dr. James M. (d. 1990) when he met her at the airport to drive her to Teec Nos Pos where he was also a teacher. For Glenda it was love at first sight and she wrote her sister that she had met the man she was going to marry. Jim proposed six months later and they were married May 24, 1969. Glenda has three children: Michelle, Laura, and James.

She dedicated her entire career to the education and advancement of minorities. As a teacher at Santa Fe Indian School, she worked with special education students and was regarded as an expert in her field. Glenda earned a Master's Degree at the University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign in 1993. She retired from Santa Fe Indian School in 2006 after serving as a teacher, Middle and Senior High Principal, Director of Planning and Evaluation, and Assistant Superintendent.

She is the proud grandmother of five and is looking forward to being part of the Amaran community.

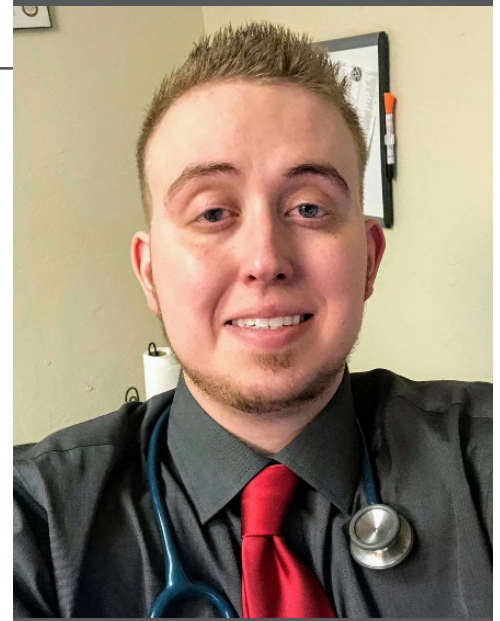
Meet our Health Services Director, Eric Freeze
