Nov 24th- Gingerbread masterpieces will be created.

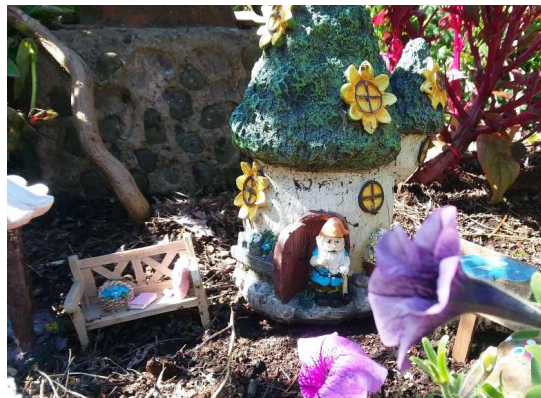
Nov 26th- Residents will be stuffed with all the trimmings.
