Our fall Resident Highlight is Claire Bourque:

I would like to take this opportunity to share one of our wonderful residents, Claire Bourque. Claire's parents, mother Fernande and Father Arthur were married in 1927 and a year later Claire was born in Massachusetts. Claire was an only child.

Growing up, Claire was very involved in her singing and acting in her school and church throughout her teen years. At the age of 15, Claire studied voice and her voice teacher arranged a singing job on WMEX in Salem, Massachusetts for two years. Claire became known for her "singing voice" and sang all around the North Shore and local towns. At the age of 17, Claire started singing with George Adams band at the USO area. Claire was also involved in plays and performed solos in plays such as "Mireille," "Cloches De Corneville" and many others.

Claire met her husband during her college days when she attended Burdett College in Lynn, Massachusetts. She was singing a solo in the chorus of St. Jean Church. Her husband (Joseph Bourque) walked in and asked his father who that was singing and stated that was the girl he was going to marry. Their first date was the following day and a year later after she graduated from college as a medical secretary, they were married. Claire and her husband were a veteran of World War II, having served in the South







Pacific. Claire and her family had the opportunity to live in several states in the United States and overseas in France. When Claire lived in Alaska working for a school, she had the pleasure of winning honorary Alaskan Air Command's representative in the service-wide 1970 military "Wife of the Year" award. This award was founded by Art Linkletter.

In the following years, Claire and her husband had six beautiful children. Raymond was the first-born son and following was their daughter Theresa, Lorraine, Bernard and her twin boys, Normand and Armand. They are also the proud grandparents of 15 grandchildren and 20 great-grandchildren.

Claire and her husband would continue singing and participate in plays throughout their life together.

Claire and her family moved to Arizona in 1986 and Claire has been a resident at Desert Springs since the first day. A special thank you from Desert Springs to Claire Bourque for volunteering for several events including lately, Bingo on Sundays and a Name That Tune game that was presented to our residents in August. 
