Thanksgiving often means to most people a massive feast and a big nap! What most people don't realize is all the history that comes with the holiday Thanksgiving. Below is a list of fun and basic facts about the beloved holiday that most Americans enjoy with lots of family.

Where the first Thanksgiving was held can be debated ...

Colonists and Wampanoag Indians shared an autumn harvest feast in 1621 in Plymouth, Massachusetts, that is widely acknowledged as one of the first Thanksgiving celebrations. But some historians argue that Florida, not Massachusetts, may have been the true site of the first Thanksgiving in North America. In 1565, nearly 60 years before Plymouth, a Spanish fleet came ashore and planted a cross in the sandy beach to christen the new settlement of St. Augustine. To celebrate the arrival and give thanks for God's providence. the 800 Spanish settlers shared a festive meal with the native Timucuan people.

 Today a staple of Thanksgiving is a big turkey and/or ham, but the original Thanksgiving featured deer and lots of local seafood (mussels, lobster, bass) plus the fruits of the first Pilgrim harvest, including pumpkin. No mashed potatoes, though. Potatoes had only been

recently shipped back to Europe

from South America.

 The first Thanksgiving was celebrated in 1621 over a threeday harvest festival. It included 50 Pilgrims, 90 Wampanoag Indians, and lasted three days. It is believed by historians that only five women were present.

Preserving Veterans' Stories

With thousands of stories of service and sacrifice, the Veterans History Project preserves and shares the firsthand accounts of America's war veterans.

Created in 2000 by the U.S. Congress, the ongoing program is part of the American Folklife Center at the Library of Congress. The personal narratives of men and women who served in all branches of the military from World War I to present-day conflicts are being collected. Their memories help document history and provide a better understanding of the realities of war for future generations.

Veterans are encouraged to share their experiences by submitting video or audio interviews, written memoirs, letters, photos and other historical documents. Families of deceased veterans can also contribute.

To date, the project has collected 108,000 stories, making it the nation's largest archive of oral history of its kind. Some accounts have been digitized and are available for viewing online.
