Concrete M Decorated for the Holidays

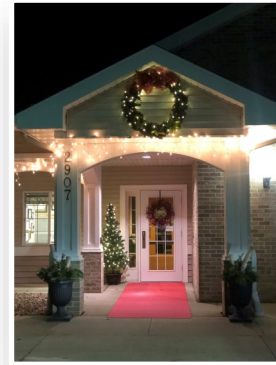

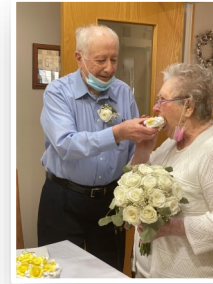
Snowbirds Stay at Glenwood Place

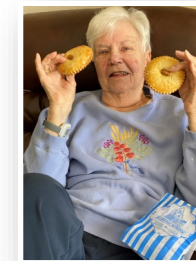
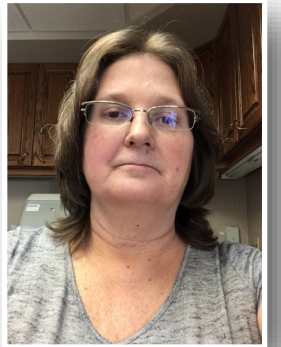

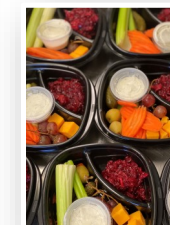
Housekeeping
