We have been advised that a resident of All Seasons West Bloomfield tested positive for COVID-19 (coronavirus). We were informed of this development this morning, December 4th, 2020. As a result of potential exposure to our community, all residents are being asked to self-quarantine whenever possible. During this 14-day period, residents will be asked to remain in their apartment homes and absolutely no visitors will be allowed on premises. Caregivers will continue to be permitted, following already established screening protocols. We appreciate your patience, cooperation and understanding during this time.

All Seasons West Bloomfield is fortunate to have a caring and committed team, and together we will work diligently to ensure the well-being of our valued residents. We will continue to provide (deliver) two meals per day to our residents, breakfast and dinner. Lunch and additional meals are available ala cart upon request. We will contact residents for daily checks on health and well-being as well as assist in the delivery of any groceries and/or personal items as needed. We will conduct weekly COVID testing at the community for all residents and team members until there are no confirmed positive tests.

Please be proactive in contacting your primary care physician and letting them know if you feel you have any signs or symptoms. Always wear your mask when you are in public spaces and wash your hands often. These are difficult steps that we are taking, but they are necessary to stop the spread of this virus and to ensure the well-being of our susceptible population of seniors.
