



On Monday December 14, 2020, the first doses of the COVID-19 vaccine were administered in the United States. This is a day that many in Senior Living Communities and many working the Senior Living Industry have long waited for.

According to the Centers for Disease Control we expect distribution to begin with Phase 1, consisting of health care workers, people in long-term care facilities, first responders, critical workers, and people with high-risk conditions. This initial distribution will be conducted through CVS and Walgreens at each community. We are hearing that some communities will see administration of the vaccine in the next 1-2 weeks. Please check with your community's administrator for more details.

Your best chance to get the vaccine by the earliest possible date is to be living in a senior living community when the vaccine becomes available in your area. Those living in senior congregate living facilities will be vaccinated before the general public.
